Reasons Why Sin Does Not Botch God's Dream For You:

Propitiation:

The word *propitiation* carries the basic idea of appeasement or satisfaction, specifically toward God. Propitiation is a two-part act that involves appeasing the wrath of an offended person (God) AND being reconciled to him (God).
