What is God's heart towards prejudice?

"Fear the Lord and judge with integrity, for the Lord our God does not tolerate perverted justice, partiality or taking of bribes." (2 Chronicles 19:7) [NLT]

Prejudice: dislike, hostility, or unjust behavior deriving from unfounded opinions.

God hates prejudices because...

- ... it _____ His very creation.
