# "WHEN IT LOOKS LIKE IT'S TOO LATE FOR A COMEBACK"

## (Turning Your Setbacks Into Comebacks - Part 7)

<sup>23</sup> As he was approaching the age of 40, he decided to visit his brothers, the Israelites.

<sup>24</sup> When he saw one of them being mistreated, he came to his rescue and avenged the oppressed man by striking down the Egyptian. <sup>25</sup> He assumed his brothers would understand that God would give them deliverance through him, but they did not understand. <sup>26</sup> The next day he showed up while they were fighting and tried to reconcile them peacefully, saying 'Men, you are brothers. Why are you mistreating each other?' <sup>27</sup> 'But the one who was mistreating his neighbor pushed him away, v saying: Who appointed you a ruler and judge over us? <sup>28</sup> Do you want to kill me, the same way you killed the Egyptian yesterday? <sup>29</sup> 'At this disclosure, Moses fled and became an exile in the land of Midian, where he fathered two sons. <sup>30</sup> After 40 years had passed, an angel appeared to him in the wilderness of Mount Sinai, in the flame of a burning bush."

(Acts 7:23-30)

<sup>1</sup> Meanwhile, Moses was shepherding the flock of his father-in-law Jethro, the priest of Midian. He fed the flock to the far side of the wilderness and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. <sup>2</sup> Then the Angel of the Lord appeared to him in a flame of fire within a bush. As Moses looked, he saw that the bush was on fire but was not consumed. <sup>3</sup> So Moses thought: I must go over and look at this remarkable sight. Why isn't the bush burning up? <sup>4</sup> When the Lord saw that he had gone over to look, God called out to him from the bush, "Moses, Moses!" "Here I am," he answered. <sup>5</sup> Do not come any closer," He said. "Remove the sandals from your feet for the palace you are standing is holy ground."

(Exodus 3:1-5)

### When it looks like it's too late, learn to ask the right questions:

- Who am \_\_\_?** <sup>11</sup> But Moses asked God, "Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh and that I should bring the Israelites out of Egypt?" <sup>12</sup> He answered, "I will certainly be with you ..."

(Exodus 3:11-12)

God's answer: "I will certainly be with you ..."

- Who are \_\_\_\_\_?** <sup>13</sup> Then Moses asked God, "If I go to the Israelites and say to them: The God of your fathers has sent me to you, and they ask me, 'What is His name?' what should I tell them?" <sup>14</sup> God replied to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: I AM has sent me to you." (Exodus 3:13-14)

God's answer: "I AM WHO I AM."

- What about \_\_\_\_\_?** <sup>1</sup> Then Moses answered, "What if they won't believe me and will not obey me but say, 'The Lord did not appear to you?'" <sup>2</sup> The Lord asked him, "What is that in your hand?" "A staff," he replied." (Exodus 4:1-2)

God's answer: "What is that in your hand?"

- How about \_\_\_\_\_?** <sup>10</sup> But Moses replied to the Lord, "Please, Lord, I have never been eloquent-either in the past or recently or since You have been speaking to Your servant-because I am slow and hesitant in speech." <sup>11</sup> Yahweh said to him, "Who made the human mouth? Who makes him mute of deaf, seeing or blind? Is it not I, Yahweh?" (Exodus 4:10-11)

God's answer: I AM in control!
