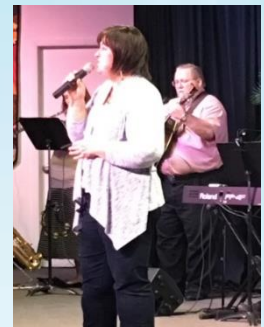

April 5, 2020 – Palm Sunday
