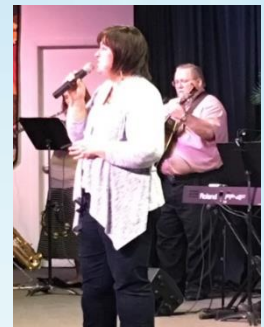

Notes

Text: "I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture." (John 10:9)
