

... **first pure**. (v. 17a)

**If I'm wise, I won't compromise my integrity.**

*He grants a treasure of common sense to the honest  
(godly). He is a shield to those who walk with  
integrity. Proverbs 2:7*

... then peace loving.

**If I'm wise, I won't antagonize your anger.**

*It is honorable for a man to resolve a dispute, but any fool can get himself into a quarrel. Proverbs 20:3*

... gentle. (v. 17c)

**If I'm wise, I won't minimize your feelings.**

*The tongue that heals is a tree of life, but a devious tongue breaks the spirit. Proverbs 15:4*

... compliant. (v. 17d)

**If I'm wise, I won't criticize your suggestions.**

*The mind of the discerning acquires knowledge, and  
the ear of the wise seeks it. Proverbs 18:15*

... full of mercy and good fruits. (v. 17e)

**If I'm wise, I won't emphasize your mistakes.**

*Love forgets mistakes; nagging about them parts the best of friends. Proverbs 17:9*



... without favoritism and hypocrisy. (v. 17f)

**If I'm wise, I won't disguise my intentions.**

*The one who conceals hatred has lying lips, and  
whoever spreads slander is a fool. Proverbs 10:18*

*And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace by  
those who cultivate peace. (v. 18)*
