**RESERVED PARKING** - Designated parking is available for all **First-time Guests** and **Senior Adults** next to the southside of the building. (See signs.)

**RESTROOMS** are located just outside the Worship Center *next to the water fountains*. We also have a Family Restroom next to the bulletin board in the Children's Wing that has a changing table and is designated specifically for adults assisting their child or disabled family member.
