Text: 1 Peter 3:1-7	
"1 Likewise, wives, be subject to your own husbands, so that even if some do not obey the word, they may be won without a word by the conduct of their wives, 2 when they see your respectful and pure conduct." (vv. 1-2)	
"She served her husband as her master, and did all she could to win him for You, speaking to him of You by her conduct, by which You made her beautiful Finally, when her husband was at the end of his earthly span, she gained him for You." - St. Augustine	
What is submission?	
"Be subject for the Lord's sake to <u>every</u> human institution." (1 Peter 2:13)	
"For to this you have been called, because Christ also suffered for you, leaving you an example, so that you might follow in his steps." (1 Peter 2:21)

"3 Do not let your adorning be external—the braiding of hair and the putting on of gold jewelry, or the clothing you wear— 4 but let your adorning be the hidden person of the heart with the imperishable beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious." (vv. 3-4)

"But let your adorning be <u>the hidden person of the heart</u> with the <u>imperishable</u> <u>beauty</u> of a gentle and quiet spirit, which in God's sight is very precious." (v.4)	,
A Biblical example of submission worth emulating.	
<sup>6</sup> For this is how the holy women who hoped in God used to adorn themselves, by submitting to their own husbands, <sup>6</sup> as Sarah obeyed Abraham, calling him lord. And you are her children, if you do good and do not fear anything that is frightening." (vv.5-6)
